Becoming a Mother After God's Heart

I will share an example of my interaction with my son. I bought him a PC for his birthday. He spent a lot of time playing on the computer, sometimes until midnight. I was worried that this would cause harm to his body and affect other family members. Out of love, I reminded him every day, but he didn't listen. I was very annoyed and had a lot of negative emotions in my heart. I began to

regret my decision to buy him a computer. I hated the existence of computers and regarded them as enemies. I became harsh when talking to my son, often with anger, blame and accusation. He responded to me with impatience, anger and disrespect, and our relationship became very tense. I think this is an obvious mirror reflection phenomenon. I prayed that God would intervene and break the computer to change my son, change his attitude towards me, change his schedule, etc. Later, when I was praying, the Holy Spirit showed and reminded me that the computer was not the problem at all, but I was the problem. God helped me see that the reason behind my anger was because I felt hurt. My son valued playing computer games more than interacting with me. He spent more time playing games than talking to me. At the same time, I was also bound by the past. My son used to be very good to me, but why did he become like this now? I was dwelling in the memories of the past... At this time, the Holy Spirit helped me remember the lessons from Teacher Anita's Victory Prayer class. When we see the bad situation of our children now, we should not be deceived, because his current situation cannot represent his future. We should learn to see the future possibilities of our children with the eyes of Jesus. We should start praying for the future of our children, so that we can change the future outcome instead of constantly worrying about past events that cannot be changed. God seems to be using a stick wake me up by. I knelt there crying and confessed my sins to God, and I started to repent.

I began to adjust my prayers. First, I put on the armor of God on myself. The blood of the Lord cleansed my mind and freed me from the bondage of negative emotions. I offered my life, soul and body to God, turned over the control of my family to God and my tongue as well. I asked God to give me words of wisdom and knowledge, and to give me a kind and gentle attitude. I also asked God to help my son build up the ability to govern and manage time, and to help him be a responsible man who knows how his every behavior will affect others, and can be sensitive to the feelings of people around him, etc. After I changed, my son also changed.

This incident was by no means accidental, but God had a good purpose for it. He wanted to help me deal with the hidden sin and rebuild my relationship with my son. I am grateful that I have been taking Teacher Anita's Victory Prayer class, learning to cooperate with the work of the Holy Spirit in prayer, overcoming the enemy's attacks, and finally obtaining victory by the power of the Lord.

On April Fool's day 2025 Ophthalmologist ordered me to get a CT Scan to determine if I have a blood clot in my brain. Praise the Lord no blood clot was found. How can I claim this? Last February 3, 2024, I fell hard on the back of my head. The injury that I sustain included swelling and slight deformity on the back of my head. After this I shared my healing experience with friends. Out of their loving concern for me they asked me to check with my primary care provider to see if I need an MRI. I followed their suggestion, but my doctor could not recommend me to get an MRI because there were no perceptible symptoms of head injury.

Can you now understand why I say that the CT Scan confirmed the power of God's healing? That is because the scan confirmed the fact that the Lord healed me through the sister when she placed her hand on me and asked for His healing for me. Praise the Lord!
